Q.1. What courses in pharmacy are being offered by the college and of what duration?

A. College offers D. Pharm., B. Pharm., M. Pharm. and Ph.D. courses. D. Pharm. course is of two years duration, B. Pharm. course is of eight semesters (four years) duration and M. Pharm. course is of four semesters (two years) duration.

Q.2. How many seats are available in each course?

Q.3. What is the approval and affiliation status of the pharmacy courses run in the college?

A. All the pharmacy courses run by the college are approved by All India Council for Technical Education and Pharmacy Council of India and affiliated to Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur. (see the relevant documents of approval available on College Website)

From session 2012-13, Lachoo Memorial College of Science and Technology, Jodhpur, has been granted autonomous status by the UGC.

Q.4. What is the accreditation status of the college?

A. College is reaccredited as 'A' Grade College with CGPA of 3.46 on 4 point scale by National Assessment and Accreditation Council -University Grants Commission (NAAC-UGC).

D.Pharm. and B.Pharm. courses were accredited by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) till 2015. For further accreditation, process is in progress.

Q.9. What is the scope and placement of Pharmacy courses?

- Recently, Government of Rajasthan has opened 15,000 Drug Distribution Counters for free distribution of drugs. Government has already recruited 1500 pharmacists and process for recruitment of 1200 pharmacists is going on and more are in the pipeline.

Q.10. What is criteria/eligibility for taking admission in above courses?

D.Pharm.: A pass in XIIth examination or intermediate examination or the first year of the three year degree course or pre-degree examination or an equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Biology/ Mathematics in XIIth examination or an equivalent examination.

Open school candidates are also eligible for admission.

Candidates appearing / appeared in supplementary examination of XIIth having result awaited may also apply.

Rajasthan State/National Level entrance test qualified candidates shall be given preference for admission.

B. Pharm.: Candidate shall have passed XIIth examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to XIIth examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and or Biology (P.C.B / P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects individually. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

Obtained at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together.

Open school candidates are also eligible for admission.

Candidates appearing / appeared in supplementary examination of XIIth having result awaited may also apply.

Rajasthan State/National Level entrance test qualified candidates shall be given preference for admission.

B. Pharm. Part II (Lateral entry): A pass in D. Pharm. course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

M.Pharm.: At least 55 % marks (aggregate of 4 years/ 3 years for lateral entry admission) [50 % for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non creamy layer)/SBC (non creamy layer) of Rajasthan state] in B.Pharm.

GPAT qualified candidates shall be given preference for admission. Such candidates are also eligible for PG Scholarship from AICTE.

Q.11. Can a candidate, not having Rajasthan State/National Level entrance test score card apply for admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm. courses ?

A. Yes, a candidate, not having Rajasthan State/National Level entrance test score card can also apply for admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm. courses. But such candidates, who have qualified Rajasthan State/National Level entrance test such as II T(Mains)/Test for B.Pharm. admission conducted by Rajasthan university of Health Sciences etc. at the time of applying shall be given preference in admission.

Q.12. Is GPAT qualified candidates are entitled for getting PG Scholarship?

A. Yes, Such candidates are entitled for PG Scholarship from AICTE.

Q.13. What is the procedure for lateral entry Admission in B.Pharm. IInd Year for D.Pharm. qualified candidates?

A. Lateral entry admission in B.Pharm. IInd Year shall be made on the basis of merit of D.Pharm. aggregate marks.

Q.14. Can a candidate having supplementary in XIIth also apply for admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm.?

A. Yes, but such candidates should pass XIIth at the time of admission.

Q.15. Is a candidate passed XIIth from open school eligible to apply for admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm.?

A. Yes, as per PCI, candidate passed XIIth from open school is also eligible.

Q.16. Are candidates belonging to any State other than Rajasthan eligible to apply?

A. All residents of India fulfilling educational qualifications are eligible to apply.

Q.17. What are the various documents required to be submitted at the time of admission?

A. Following documents are required in original at the time of admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm.:

- Mark Sheet of XIIth (Senior Secondary).
- Marks Sheet/Certificate of X (Secondary School Exam.) for date of birth.
- Caste Certificate (if applicable) for the purpose of any scholar ship given by Social welfare Dept.
- Rajasthan State/National Level entrance test scorecard if applicable.
- Aadhaar Card

Following documents are required in original at the time of admission in M.Pharm.:

- Marks Sheet of all years/Semester of B.Pharm. Certificate of conversion formula is required, if applicable.
- Marks Sheet/Certificate of Xth (Secondary School Exam.) for date of birth.

Q.18. What is the fee structure?

A. The fee structure is as follows:

D.Pharm.: Rs. 70,600/- per annum + Rs 1400/- examination fee (to be paid at the time of admission) + Rs. 2,500/- caution money (refundable)

B.Pharm.: Rs. 45,300/- per semester + Rs 1400/- examination fee (to be paid at the time of admission) + Rs. 2,500/- caution money (refundable)

M.Pharm.: Rs. 50,300/- per semester + Rs 2600/- examination fee (to be paid at the time of admission) + Rs. 2,500/- caution money (refundable)

Q.19. What is fee refund policy in case of cancellation of admission?

A. Fee shall be refunded as per UGC rules dated 06.12.2016.

Q.20. Is there any hostel facility available in the college?

A. Hostel is not available. College is situated in the heart of the city at Shastri Nagar and rooms are available on rent in nearby areas.

Q.21. Is there any Uniform for these courses?

A. Yes, students are required to wear prescribed uniform on all days.

Q.22. Is there any book bank facility available?

A. Yes, set of text books are provided to students of D.Pharm. and B.Pharm. from book bank free of cost. In addition to this, students are provided with I-card cum library card. Two books are issued for 14 days on this library card.
