Q.1. What courses in pharmacy are being offered by the College and of what duration?

A. College offers D. Pharm. And B. Pharm., D. Pharm. is a two years Diploma course, B. Pharm. is a four years (eight semesters) Degree course and B. Pharm. Part-II (Lateral Entry) is of three years (six semester) duration.

Q.2. How many seats are available in each course?

A. D. Pharm. : 60
B. Pharm. : 60
B.Pharm. Part-II (Lateral Entry) : 12

Q.3. What is the approval and affiliation status of the Pharmacy courses run in the College?

A. All the pharmacy courses run by the college are approved by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and affiliated to Jai Narain Vyas University, Jodhpur. (see the relevant documents of approval available on College Website)

Q.4. What is the accreditation status of the College?

A. College is accredited as 'A' Grade College (Third Cycle) by National Assessment and Accreditation Council-University Grants Commission (NAAC-UGC).

D.Pharm. and B.Pharm. courses were accredited by National Board of Accreditation (NBA) till 2015.

Q.5. What is the meaning of Autonomous College and what are its advantages?

A. Autonomy is the highest status awarded to a College by UGC. Autonomous college is granted autonomy with respect to design of curriculum, conduct of examination etc. The autonomous college conducts its own examination and affiliating university awards Diploma/ Degrees. Q.10. What are the criteria/eligibility for taking admission in above courses?

D.Pharm.: A pass in XIIth examination or intermediate examination or the first year of the three year degree course or pre-degree examination or an equivalent examination as approved by PCI with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Biology/ Mathematics in XIIth examination or an equivalent examination.

Open school candidates are also eligible for admission.

Candidates having their XIIth class result awaited/ having supplementary in XIIth class can also apply but they are required to submit their result at the time of admission.

Frequently Asked Questions

B. Pharm.: Candidate shall have passed XIIth examination conducted by the respective state/ central government authorities recognized as equivalent to XIIth examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and/ or Biology (P.C.B/ P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects individually. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

Open school candidates are also eligible for admission.

Candidates appearing/ appeared in main/ supplementary examination of XIIth having result awaited can also apply. Such candidates are required to submit their result at the time of admission.

B. Pharm. Part-II (Lateral Entry): A pass in D. Pharm. course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

Q.11. What is the procedure for lateral entry Admission in B.Pharm. Part-II for D.Pharm. qualified candidates?

A. Lateral entry admission in B.Pharm. Part-II shall be made on the basis of merit of D.Pharm. aggregate marks.

Q.12. Can a candidate having supplementary in XIIth also apply for admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm.?

A. Yes, but such candidates should pass XIIth at the time of admission.

Q.13. Is a candidate passed XIIth from open school eligible to apply for admission in D.Pharm. and B.Pharm.?

A. Yes, as per PCI, candidate passed XIIth from open school is also eligible.

Q.14. Are candidates belonging to any State other than Rajasthan eligible to apply?

A. All residents of India fulfilling educational qualifications are eligible to apply.

Q.15. What are the various documents required to be submitted at the time of admission?

A. Following documents are required in original at the time of admission in **D.Pharm.** and **B.Pharm.:**

- 1) XIIth Mark Sheet
- 2) Xth Marks Sheet/ Certificate of Xth (Secondary School Exam.) for date of birth
- 3) Caste Certificate (if applicable) for the purpose of scholar ship given by Social Welfare Dept.
- 4) Aadhaar Card
- 5) Transfer Certificate (TC)

Following documents are required in original at the time of admission in **B.Pharm. Part-II (Lateral Entry):**

- 1) Marksheets of D.Pharm Part-I and D.Pharm. Part-II
- 2) Xth Marks Sheet/ Certificate of Xth (Secondary School Exam.) for date of birth
- 3) Caste Certificate (if applicable) for the purpose of scholar ship given by Social Welfare Dept.
- 4) Aadhaar Card
- 5) Transfer Certificate (TC)
- 6) Migration Certificate if applicable.

Q.16. What is the fee structure?

A. The fee structure is as follows:

D.Pharm.: Yearly fee Rs. 81765/-) + Rs. 1,400/- examination fee per year + Rs. 2,500/- caution money (One time).

Rs 44783 /- (50% of Yearly Fee+ Exam fee + Caution Money) to be paid at the time of admission.

Rs 40882 (50% of Yearly Fee) to be paid in the month of November/ December.

B.Pharm. & B. Pharm. Part-II (Lateral Entry): Yearly fee Rs. 104765/-) + Rs. 2,800/- Examination fee per year + Rs. 2,500/- caution money (One time).

Rs 56283/- (50% of Yearly Fee+50% of exam fee + Caution Money) to be paid at the time of admission.

Rs 53782/- (50% of Yearly Fee+50% of exam fee) to be paid at the beginning of next semester in the month of November/ December.

Q.17. What is fee refund policy in case of cancellation of admission?

A. Fee shall be refunded as per UGC notification dated October, 2018 on 'Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates'.

Refund of Caution Money: Caution Money shall be refunded on completion of course or when a student leaves the course in between and takes the TC from the college.

Q.18. Is there any hostel facility available in the college?

A. Hostel is not available. College is situated in the heart of the city at Shastri Nagar and rooms are available on rent in nearby areas.

Q.19. Is there any Uniform for these courses?

A. Yes, students are required to wear prescribed uniform on all days.

Q.20. Is there any book bank facility available?

A. Yes, set of text books are provided to students of D.Pharm. and B.Pharm. from book bank free of cost. In addition to this, students are provided with I-card cum library card. Two books are issued for 14 days on this library card.
