Jai Narain Vyas University, formerly known as University of Jodhpur. University of Jodhpur was Established in 1962, and following four Government Colleges of Jodhpur became part of the University.

I. MBM Engineering College (Now Faculty of Engineering & Architecture (11 Department)),

II. Jaswant College (now Faculty of Commerce & Management Studies with 04 Departments),

III. S.M.K. College (now Faculty of Law and Campus of Institute of Evening Studies and also being used presently for Under graduate teaching of Faculty of Arts. This also houses Coaching Centre for Weaker Sections),

IV. K.N. College for Women (The multi-faculty constituent college of the University).

Dr. S. Radhakrishnan, the President of India inaugurated the then University of Jodhpur on 24th August, 1962. In his inaugural address the Hon'ble President revered Prof. Radha Krishnan desired and defined the goals and objective "That the young people, who will be educated in this university, will go forward not as prisoners of the past, but as pilgrims of the future; will develop in them a spirit of dedication, a spirit of renunciation, a spirit of whole-hearted, single-minded concentration on the advancement of the knowledge, whether in science or humanities."

This was the only residential University in the State of Rajasthan, catering mainly the needs of students of western Rajasthan (the Marwar). Since, this University is located in the great Indian Thar Desert, its R&D activities centered on heritage, society and challenges of the region. This is the Western most University of the country and imparts education and conducts research in border areas neighboring Pakistan. It is our endeavor to provide education not only to citizens of the Desert/border Districts but

also to the wards of Defence/Paramilitary forces and other Organizations which are working in strategically important sectors of the country.
Jai Narain Vyas University is now a divisional university for western part of the Rajasthan State.

Subject: Fee Refund Policy 2024-25

आदरणीय महोदय/महोदय,

The University Grants Commission receives many representations/complaints from students/parents on the non-refund of fees by the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) on cancellation/withdrawal of admissions.

2. Students should be allowed a full refund of fees within a specified period to enable them to opt for a course of their choice.
3. The Commission has considered the matter in its 580th meeting held on 15 May 2024, and after considering the relevant factors decided, the following fee refund policy for the academic session 2024-25:

- a. Notwithstanding anything contained in any guidelines/ prospectus/ notification/ schedule, a full refund of fees shall be made by the HEIs on account of all cancellations of admissions/migrations of students up to 30 September 2024 and with a deduction of not more than Rs. 1,000, as a processing fee, up to 31 October 2024.
- b. It shall apply to all higher education institutions, whether established or incorporated by or under a Central Act or a State Act, and every institution recognized by the University Grants Commission under clause (f) of Section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and to all institutions deemed to be a University declared as such under Section 3 therein and to all higher education institutions affiliated to a University.
- c. These guidelines would also be applicable to organizations, consortiums, committees, associations, etc., constituted for the purpose of conducting counselling or processing admissions and collecting fees on behalf of participating HEIs, and the HEI concerned will be responsible for refund fees.
- d. For any admission schedule extending/commencing beyond/after 31 October 2024, the provisions contained in the UGC Notification issued in October 2018 on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates shall apply (reproduced below for ready reference):

Category	Percentage of Refund of fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days after formally notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission

- e. This policy will remain in force for subsequent academic sessions until the issuance of a revised policy by the UGC.

4. It may also be noted that the UGC has notified the Redressal of Grievances of Students Regulations, 2023, wherein "*delay in, or denial of, the refund of fees due to a student who withdraws admission within the time mentioned in the prospectus, subject to guidelines, if any, issued by the Commission, from time to time*" has been defined as one of the grievances.

5. The Higher Education Institutions are requested to ensure compliance with the fee refund policy for the academic session 2024-25 and redress any grievance by the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023.

6. Any HEI violating the provisions of UGC Fee Refund Policy 2024-25 shall be liable for punitive action as notified in Clause 5 of the UGC Notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates issued in October 2018.

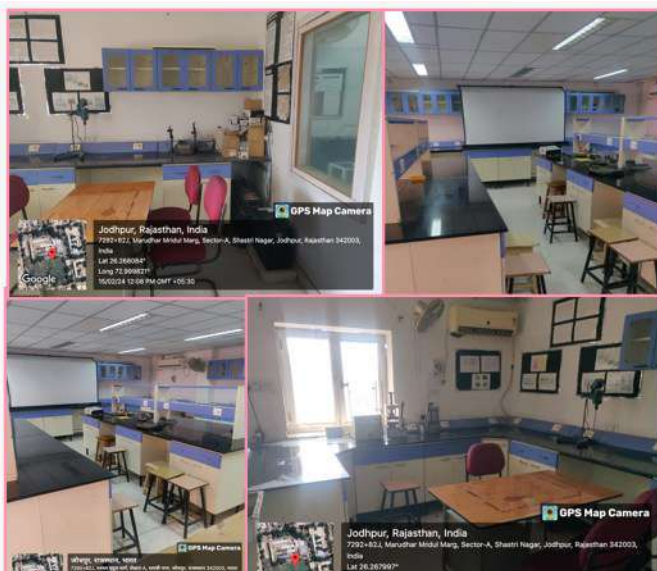

Internal Complaint Committee

Introduction

The Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) at Lachoo Memorial College of Science & Technology is established in accordance with the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act, 2013. The ICC is dedicated to creating a safe, secure, and inclusive environment for all students, faculty, and staff.

Why ICC?

- It is formed according to the provisions of the POSH ACT-Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act of 2013, 9th December 2013. (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal).
- It is also mentioned in University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015- 2nd May 2016.

Objectives

1. Prevention of Sexual Harassment:

- To promote a workplace free from sexual harassment through education and awareness programs.
- To foster a respectful and safe environment where everyone can work without fear of discrimination or harassment.

2. Awareness and Education:

- To conduct workshops and seminars to sensitize employees and students about their rights and responsibilities.
- To provide information about the mechanisms available for redressal of complaints.

3. Redressal of Complaints:

- To ensure a prompt and fair investigation of complaints related to sexual harassment.
- To take appropriate actions based on the findings of the investigation to ensure justice and prevent recurrence.

4. Support and Counseling:

- To offer support and counseling services to complainants and respondents during the investigation process.
- To maintain confidentiality and respect for the dignity of all parties involved.

5. Monitoring and Evaluation:

- To regularly review and assess the effectiveness of policies and procedures related to the prevention of sexual harassment.
- To recommend necessary amendments to policies to ensure a safe and inclusive environment.

Functioning

1. Filing of Complaints:

- Any student, faculty, or staff member who feels they have been subjected to sexual harassment can file a complaint with the ICC.
- Complaints must be submitted in writing and include relevant details of the incident(s).

2. Investigation Process:

- Upon receipt of a complaint, the ICC will conduct a thorough investigation in a timely manner.
- The investigation will be carried out with due regard to confidentiality and fairness, ensuring that both the complainant and the respondent have the opportunity to present their case.

3. Recommendations and Actions:

- Based on the investigation findings, the ICC will make recommendations for corrective actions to the appropriate authorities.
- Actions may include disciplinary measures, counseling, or training programs.

4. Confidentiality:

- The ICC ensures that all proceedings, information, and documents related to a complaint are kept confidential and shared only on a need-to-know basis.

5. Reporting:

- The ICC will prepare an annual report detailing the number of cases received, investigated, and resolved, and submit it to the college authorities and relevant external bodies as required by law.

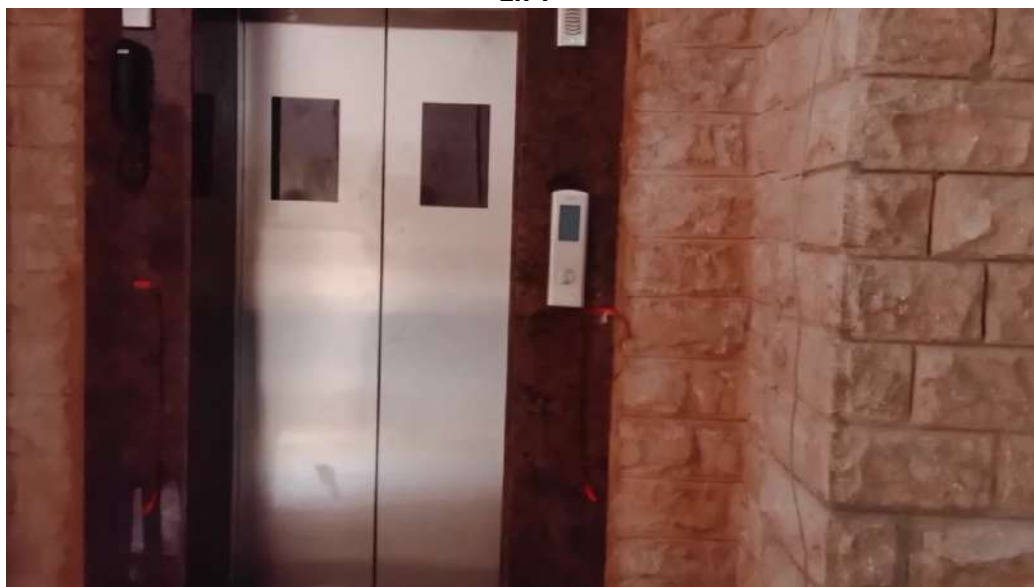
